

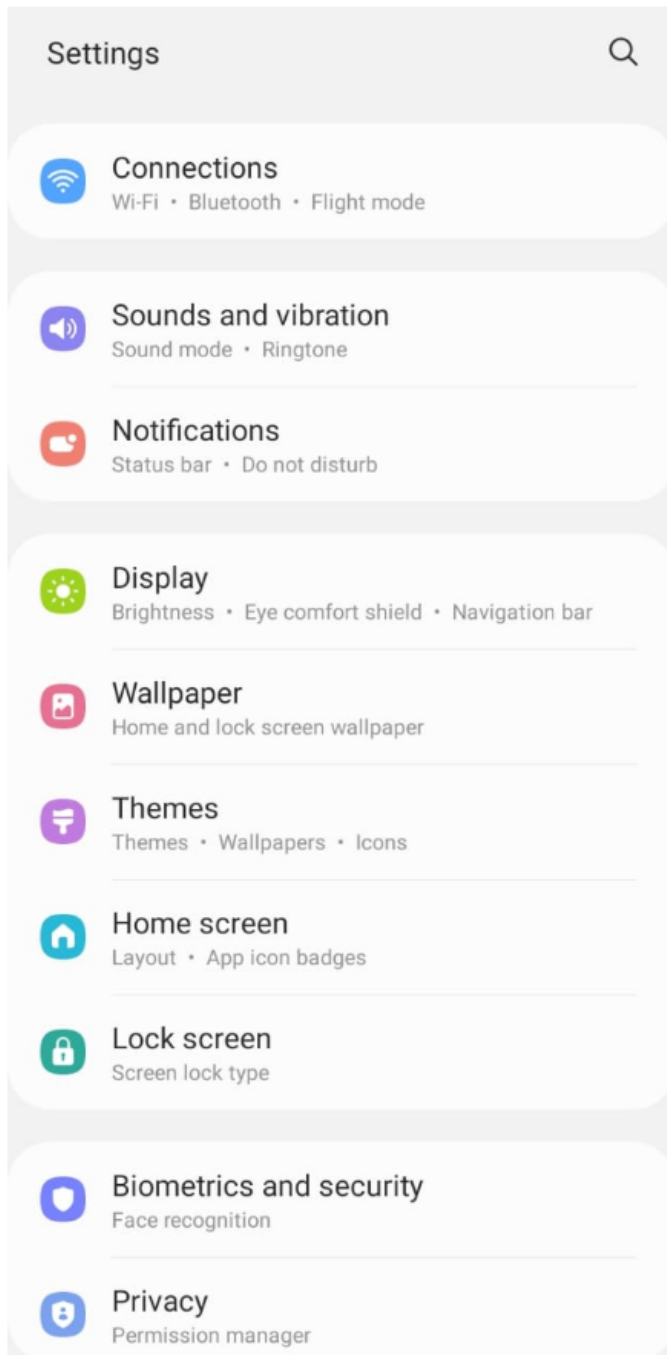
How to connect DDOS IP on Android

Please follow the step-by-step guide to setup PureVPN DDOS IP Add-on on your Android system manually.

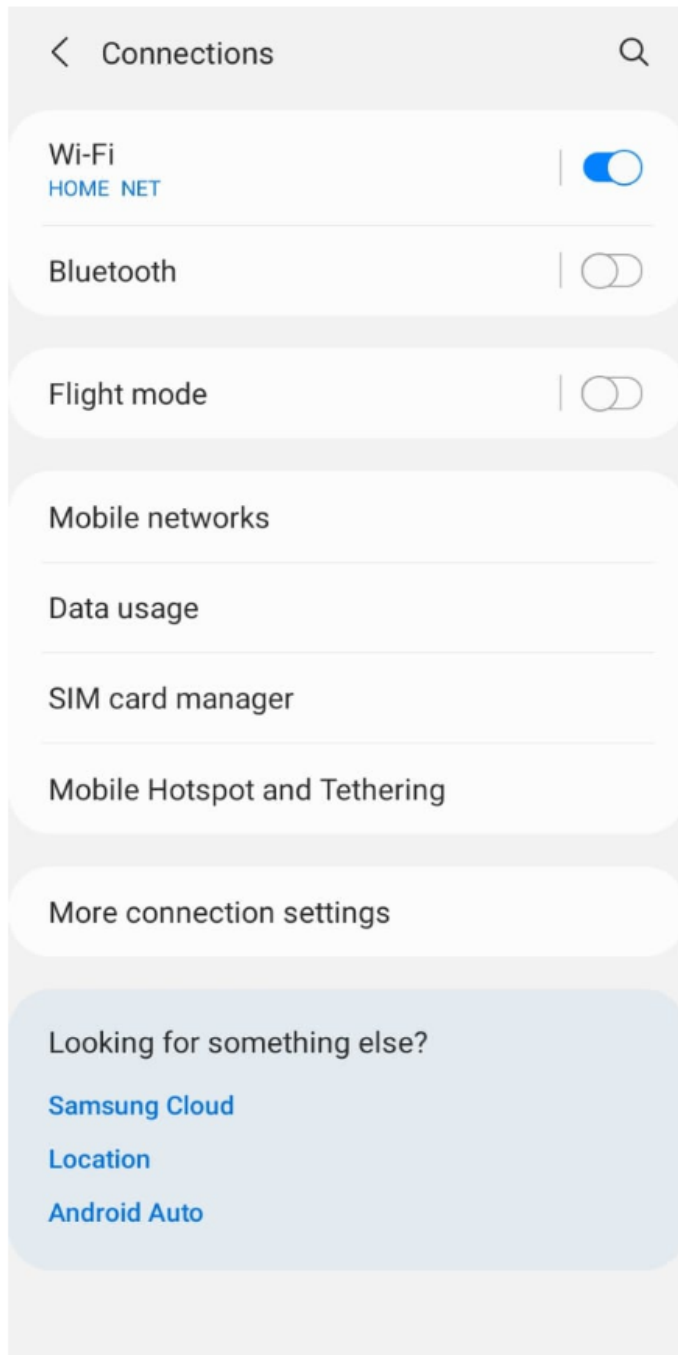
- Tap Settings.



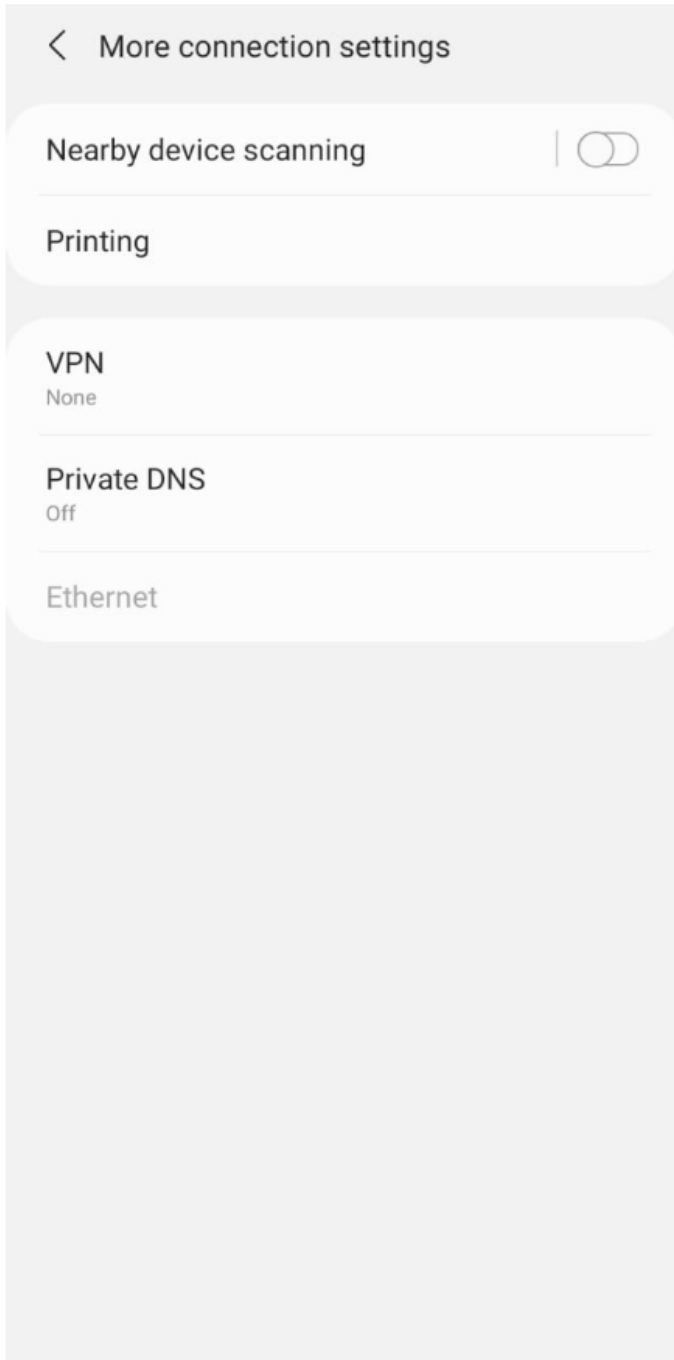
- Tap Connection.



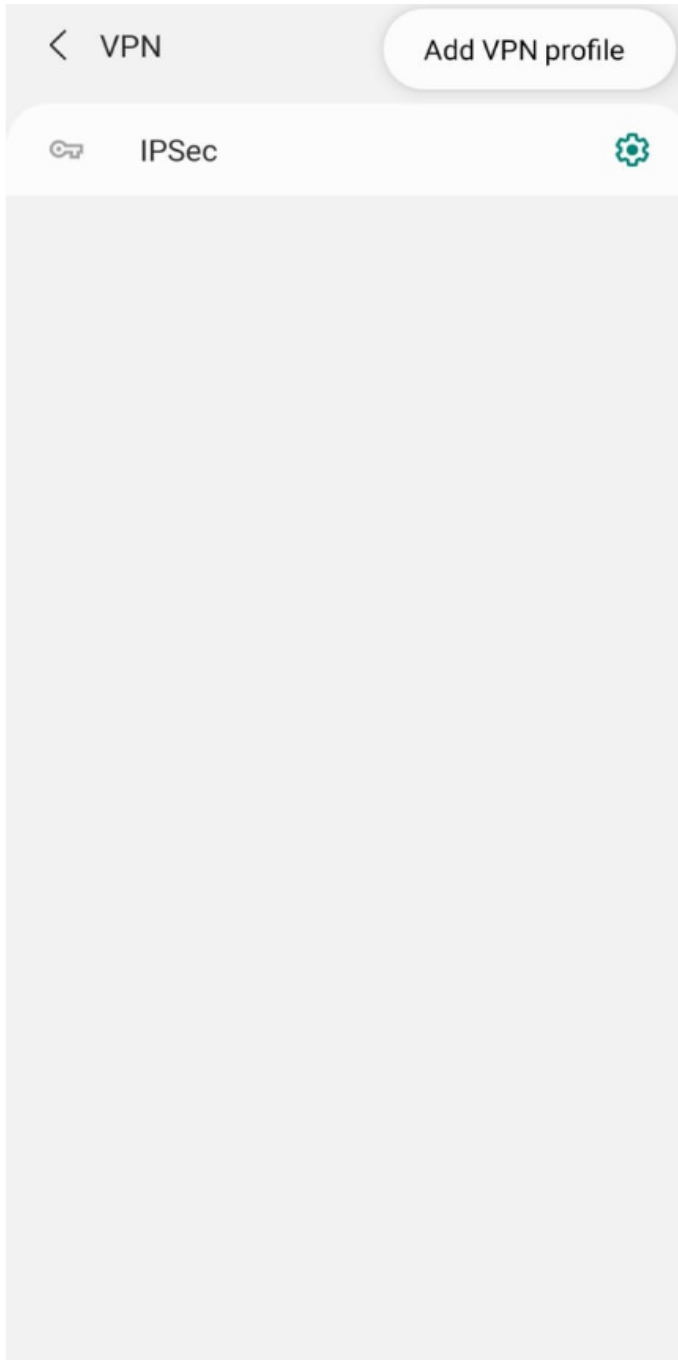
- Tap More connection settings.

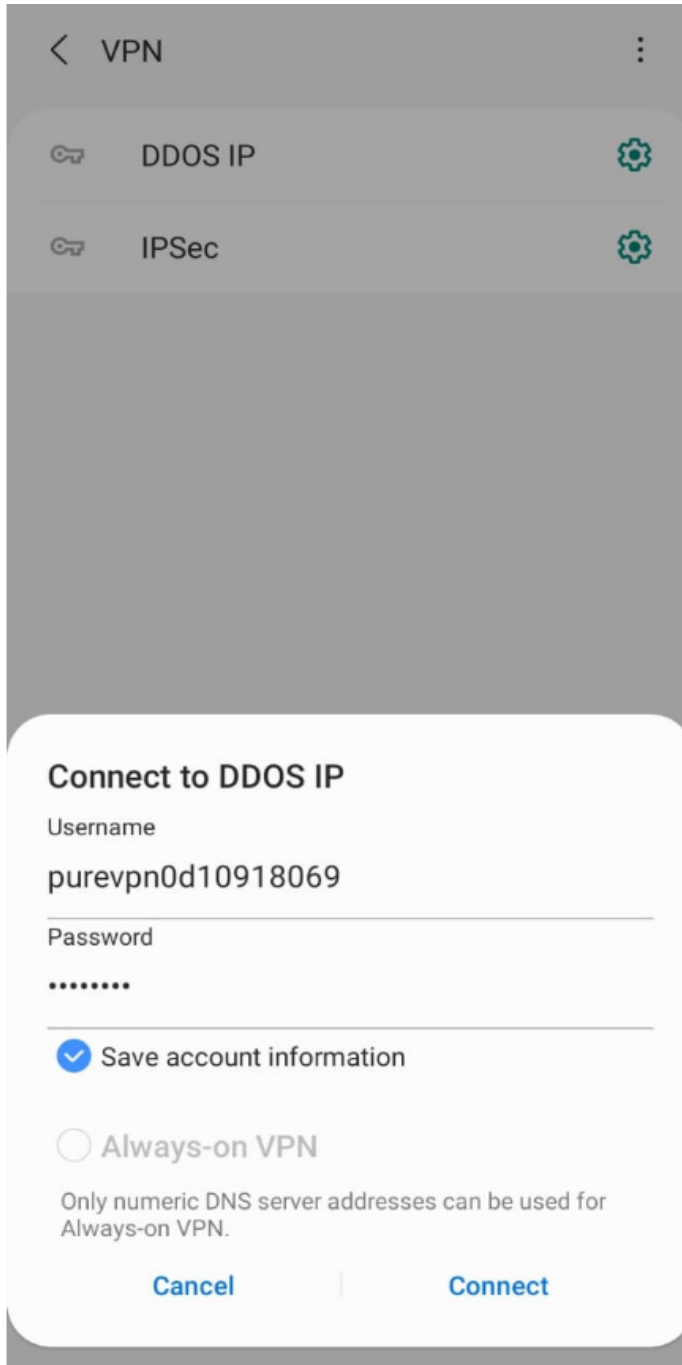
