

How to configure PureVPN with NetDuma and Nighthawk

Things to Consider:

Before you begin, please make sure that:

You have a working internet connection
VPN Supported Router.

Own a premium PureVPN account (If you do not already own one, you can buy a subscription from [here](#))

Configuring Netduma and Nighthawk:

We know PureVPN is already added in NetGear Genie R7800.

Username: Your username provided by PureVPN

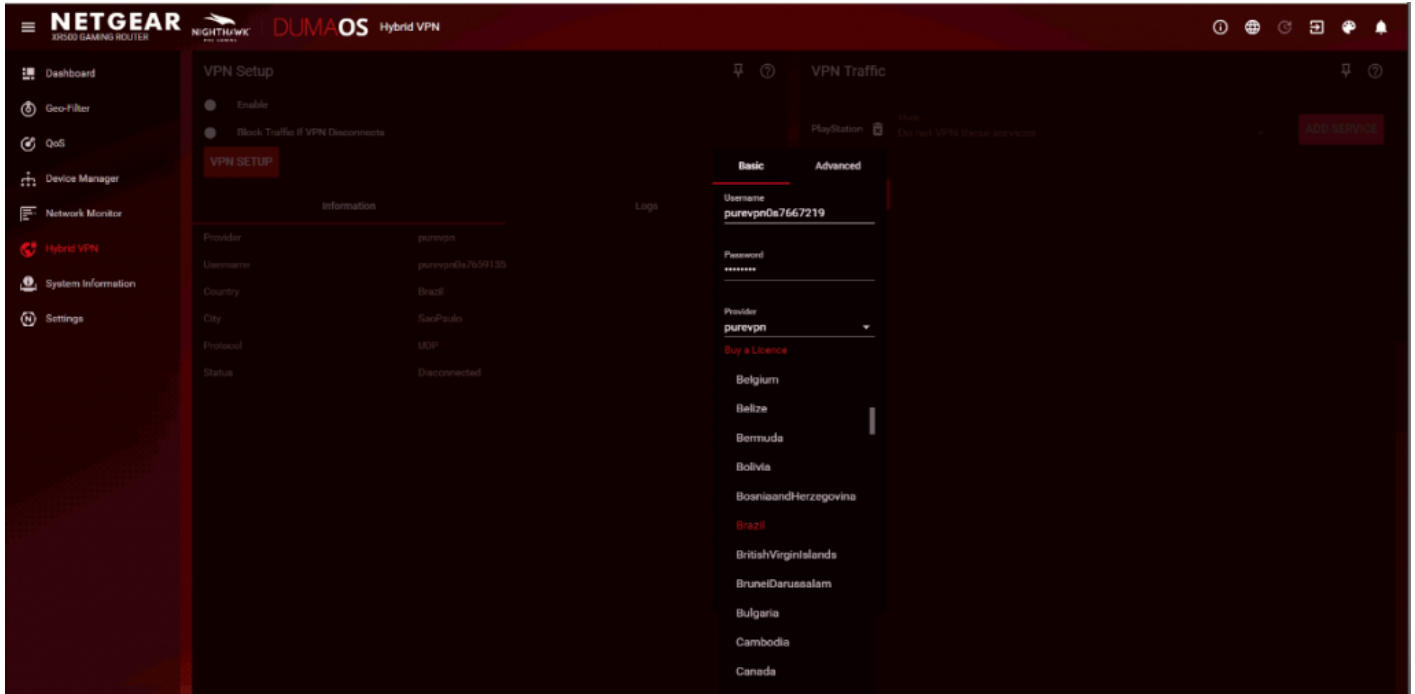
Password: Your password provided by PureVPN

(Important Note: Your email address is not your VPN login username.)

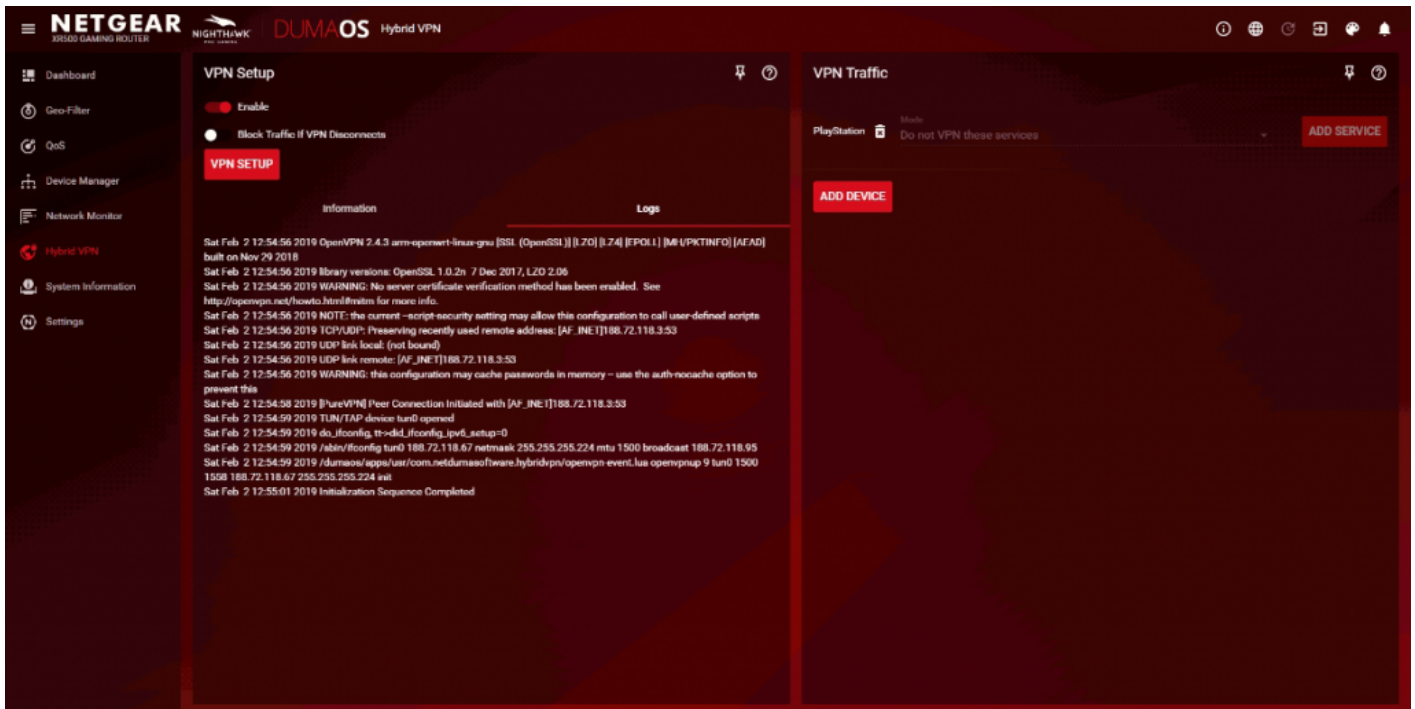
Provider: PureVPN

Protocol: Select either TCP or UDP
