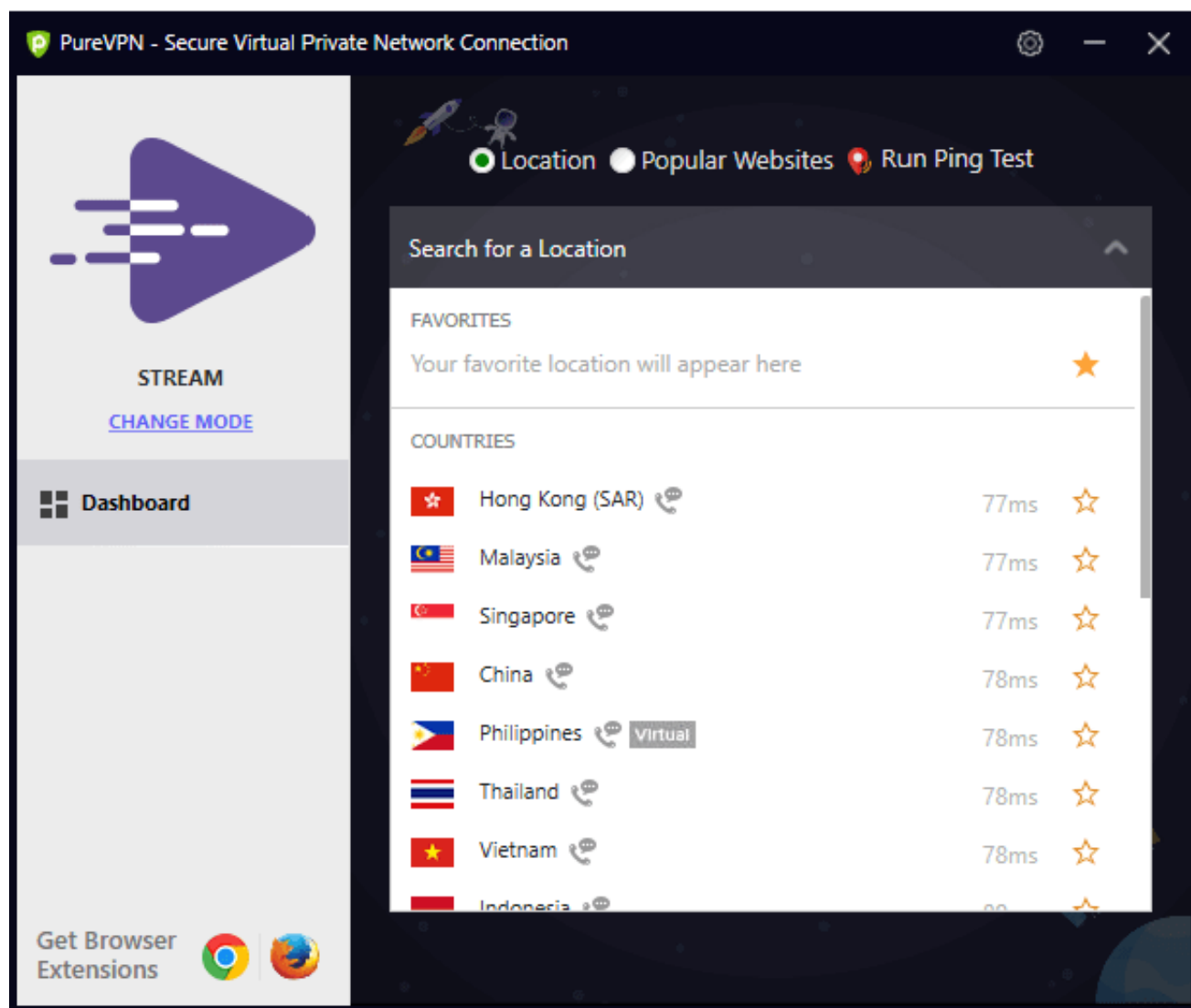


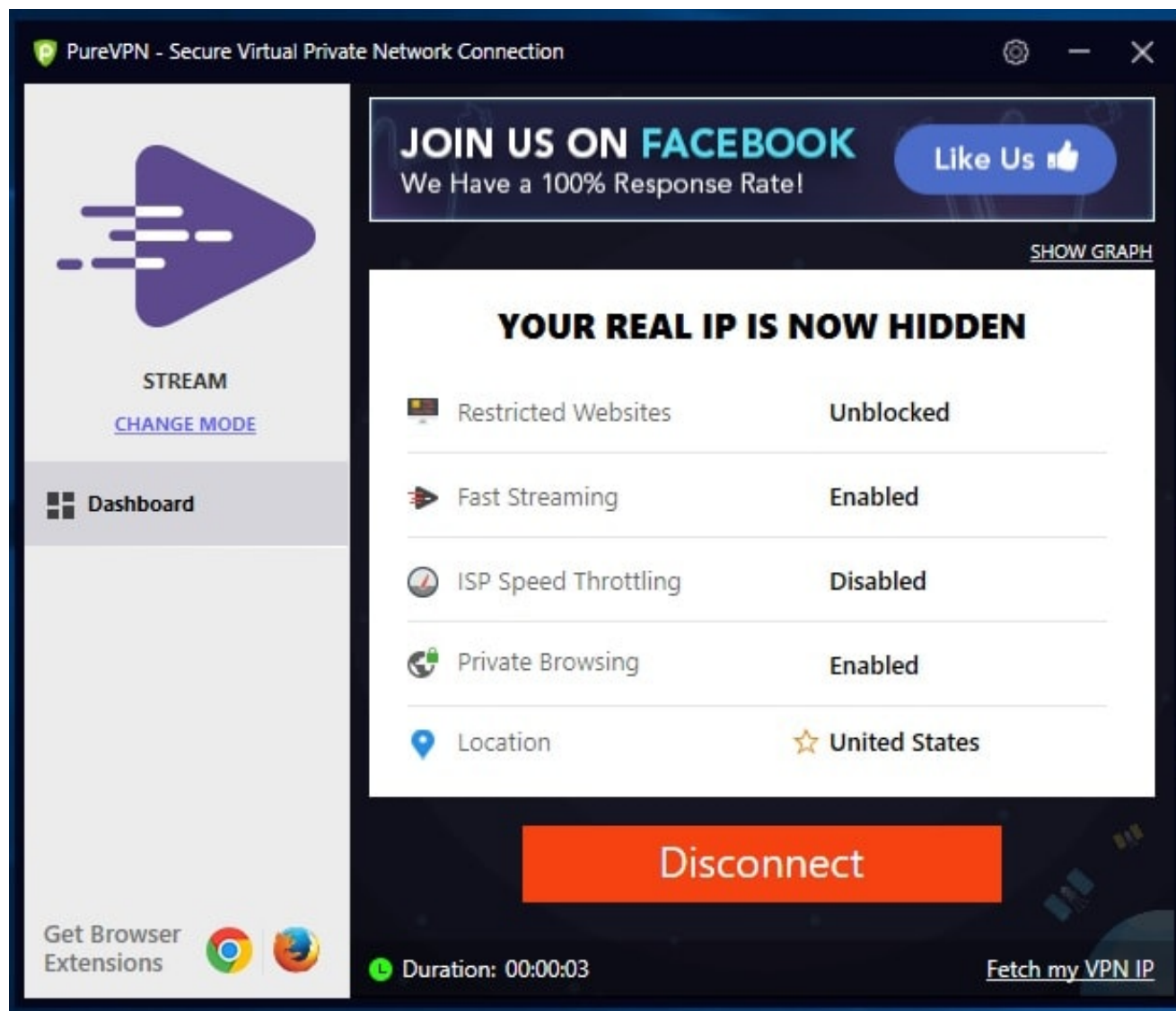
How to Fetch VPN IP in PureVPN Windows App

With PureVPN, you can check your newly assigned IP address in just a few clicks. Here's how to go about it.

1 Connect to your desired location.



2 Once your VPN connection is established, click Fetch my VPN IP in the bottom right corner.



3 Your VPN IP will then be displayed in PureVPN's Windows client.
