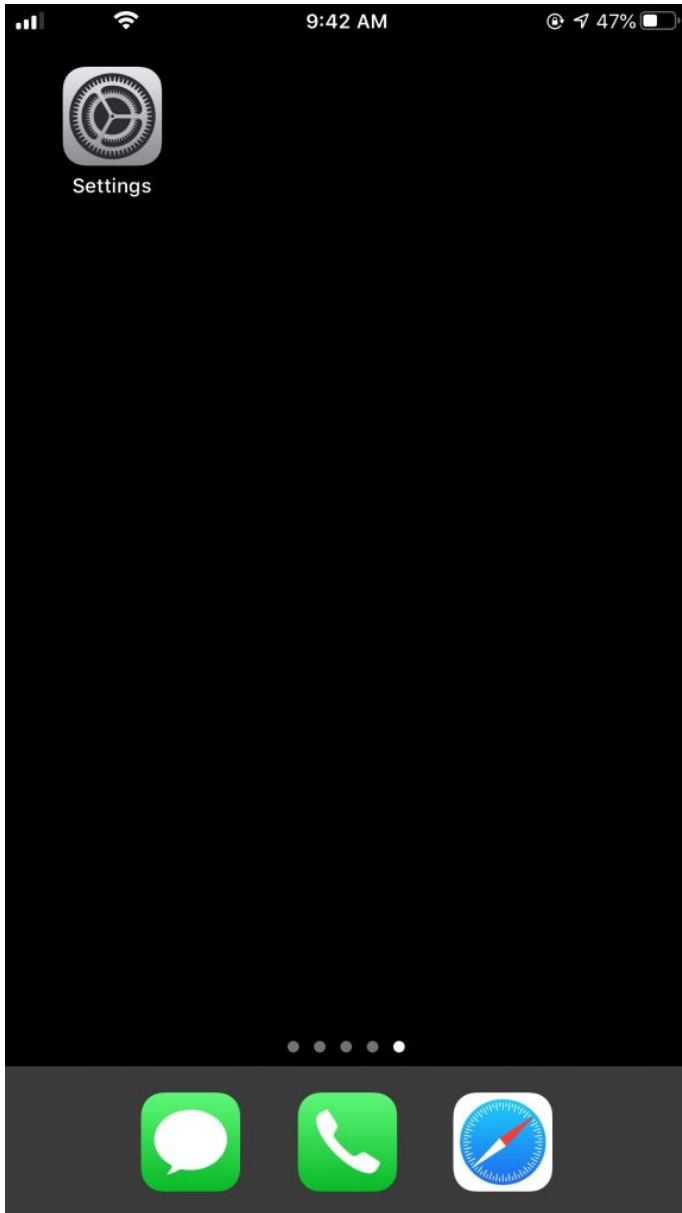


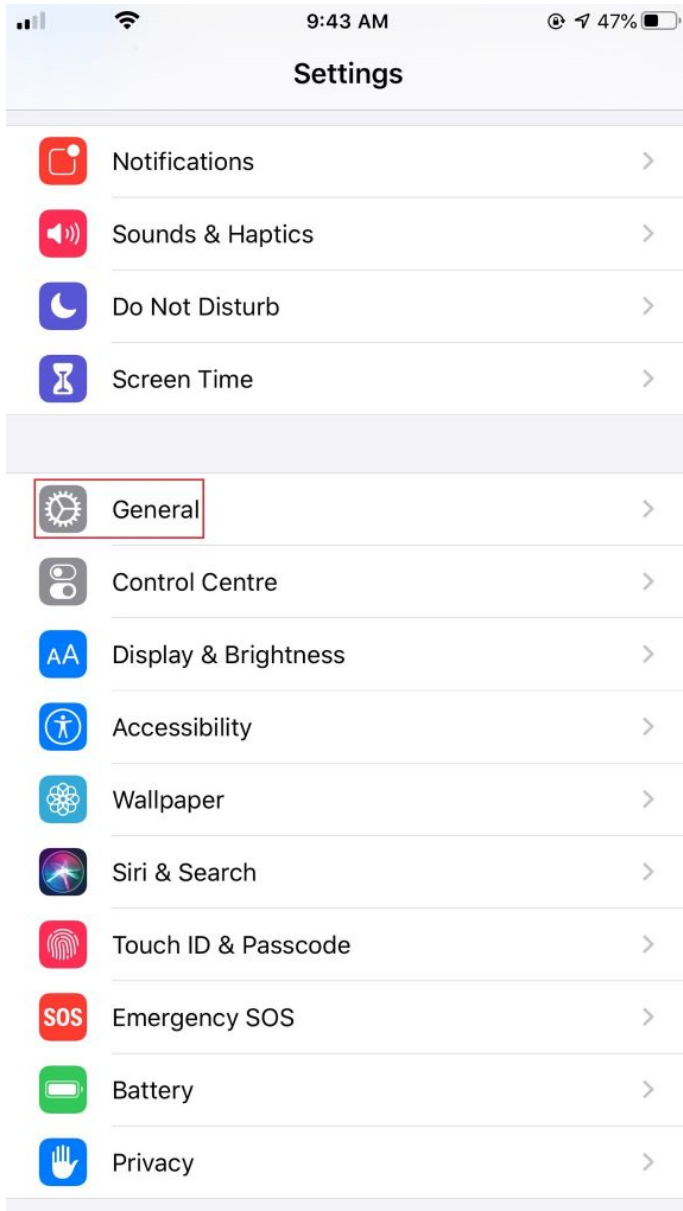
How to setup IPsec on iOS

The following guide will help you configure IPsec on your iOS device so you can enjoy complete internet freedom & security.

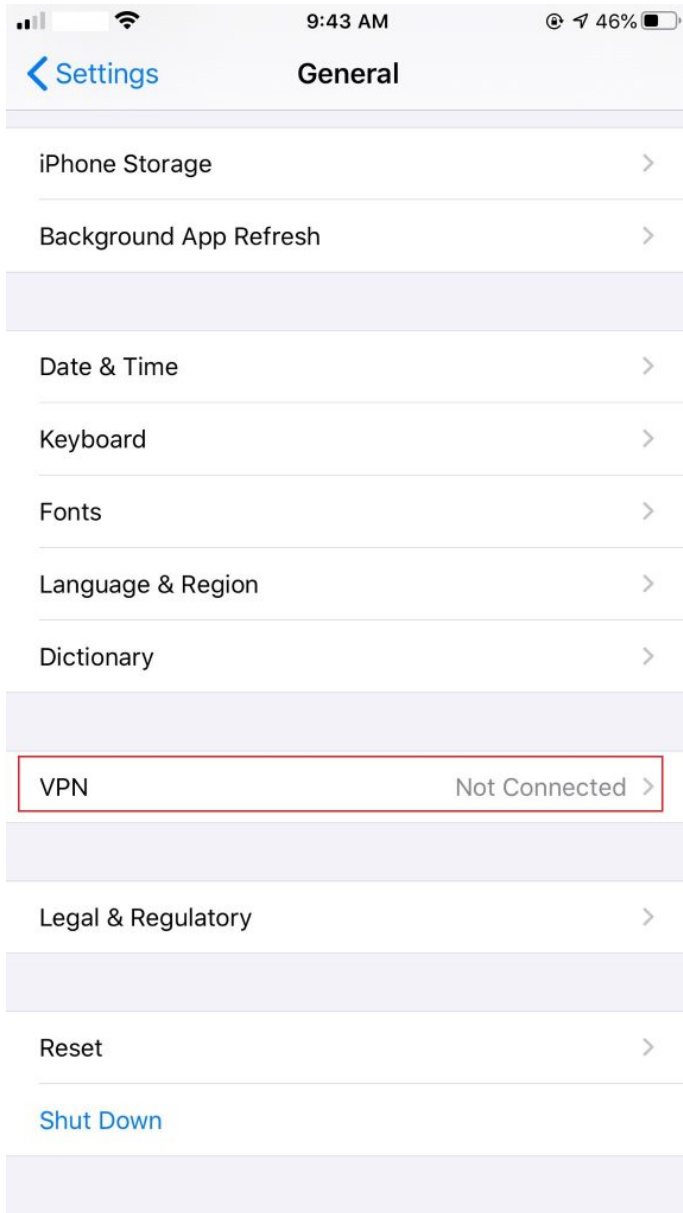
1 Tap **Settings**.



2 Tap **General**.



3 Tap **VPN**.



4 Tap **Type** and select **IPsec** as your protocol selection.

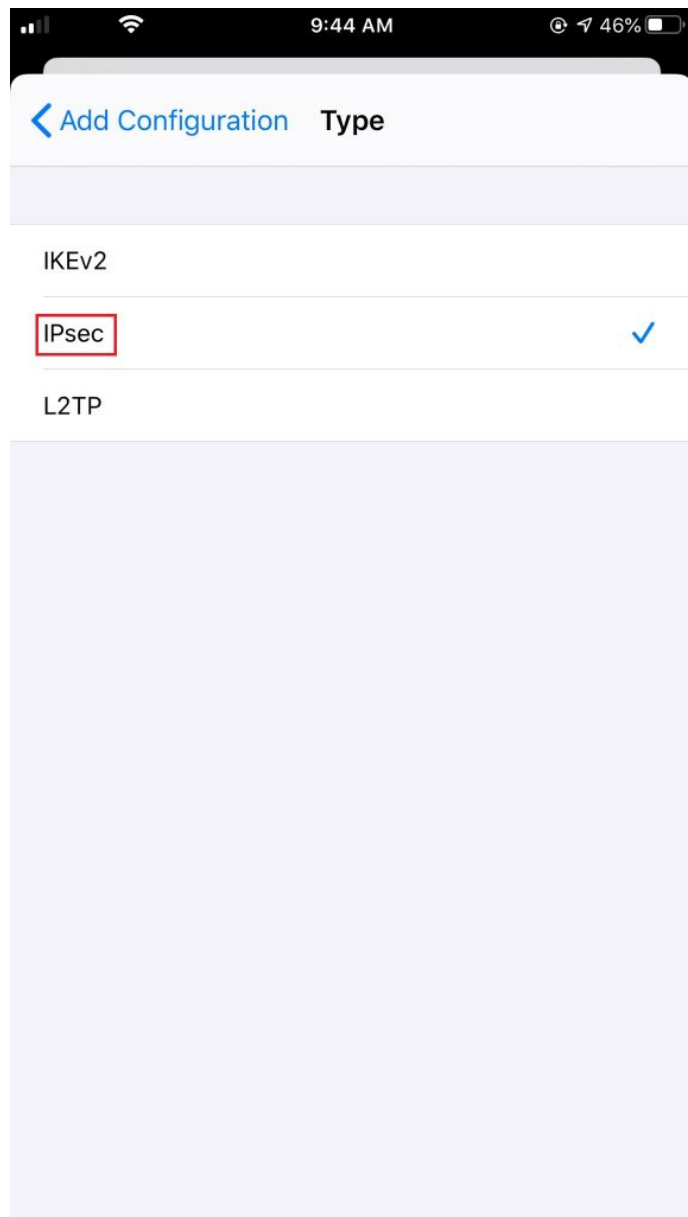

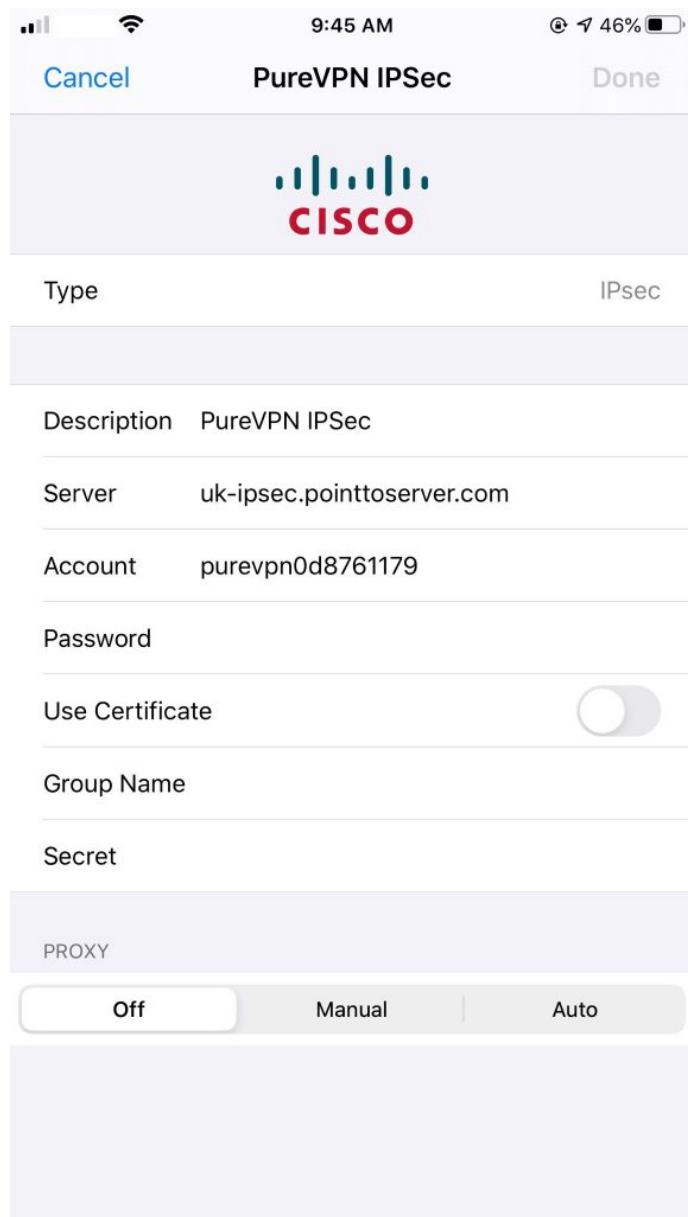

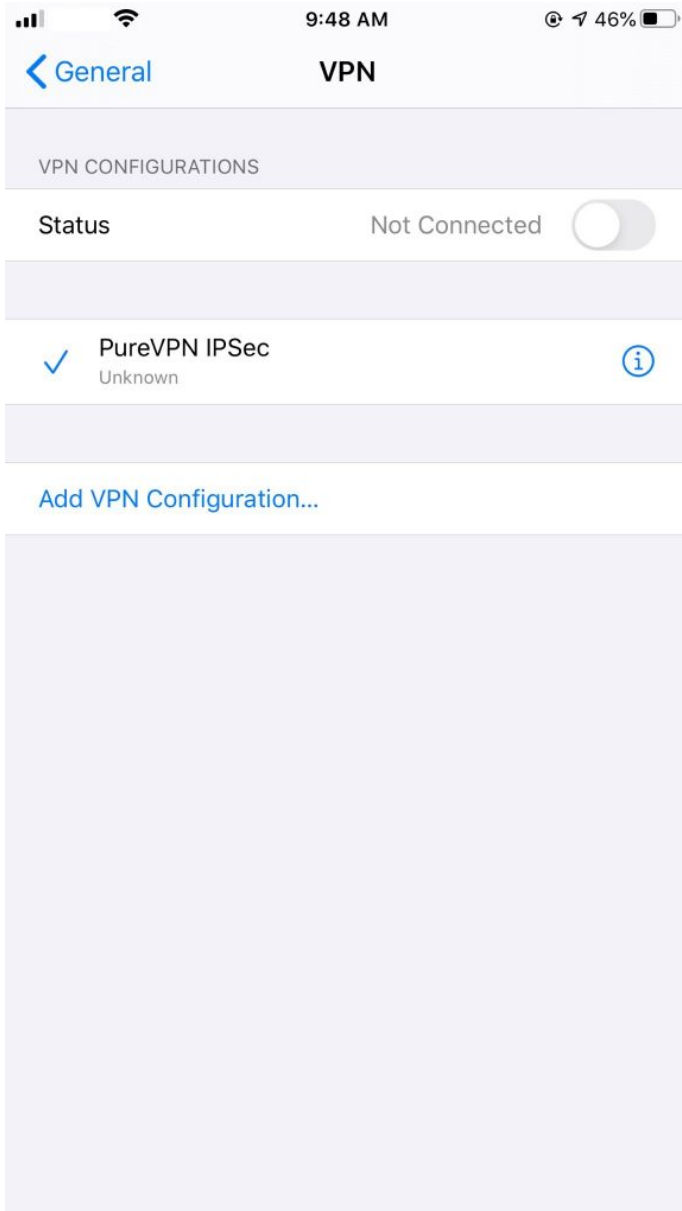

- **Proxy: OFF**

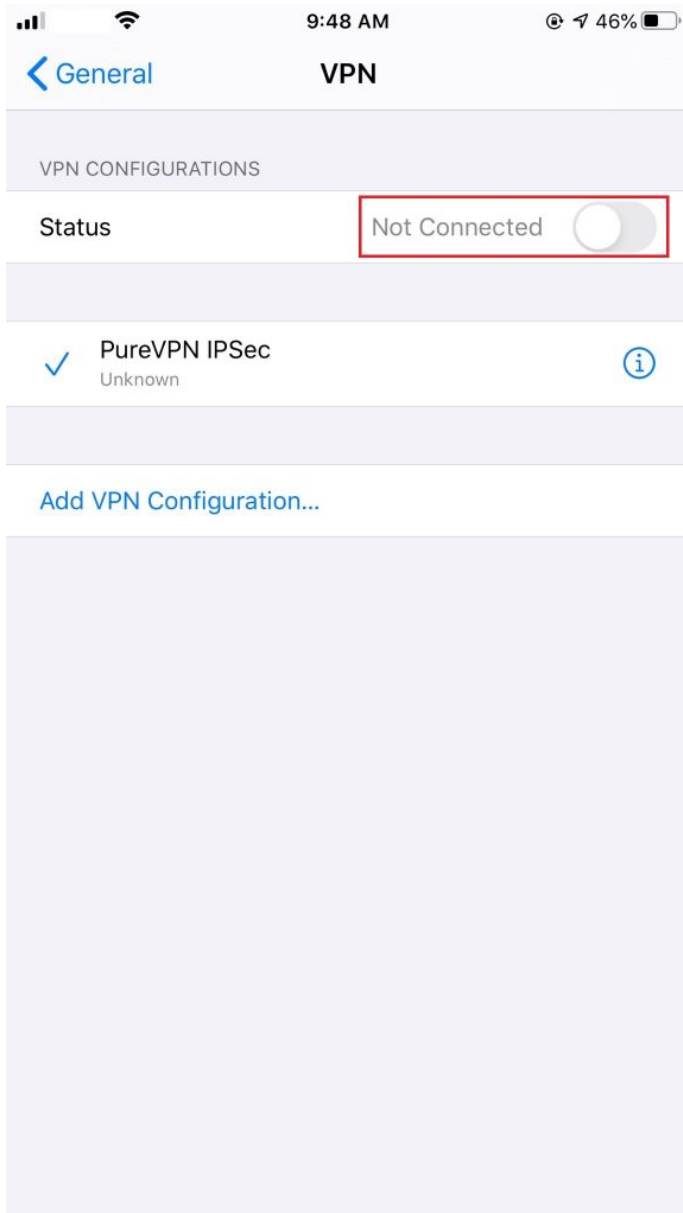


6 After you've entered all the details, tap **Done** from the top right corner of your screen.
