

How to setup PureVPN on D-Link Router?

Configuring a PureVPN tunnel on your router is a great way to ensure the safety and security of all the devices in your home. This method is especially beneficial if you have devices that don't have VPN compatibility or you want to protect all the Wi-Fi-connected devices in your home.

To be able to take advantage of PureVPN across any and all devices via your D-Link router, We used the D-Link DIR 842 (Firmware Version L 2.x) for this how-to. There are so many models of D-Link routers, and so not all of them can be entertained. However, this should give you a general idea of how the setup process will be, here is what you need to do:

Things to Consider:

1. You have a working internet connection
2. VPN Supported Router.
3. A Premium PureVPN account (If you haven't bought yet click ?[here](#) to buy)

Find your VPN credentials for manual configuration.

- Login to the **Member area** using your PureVPN registered email address and password.

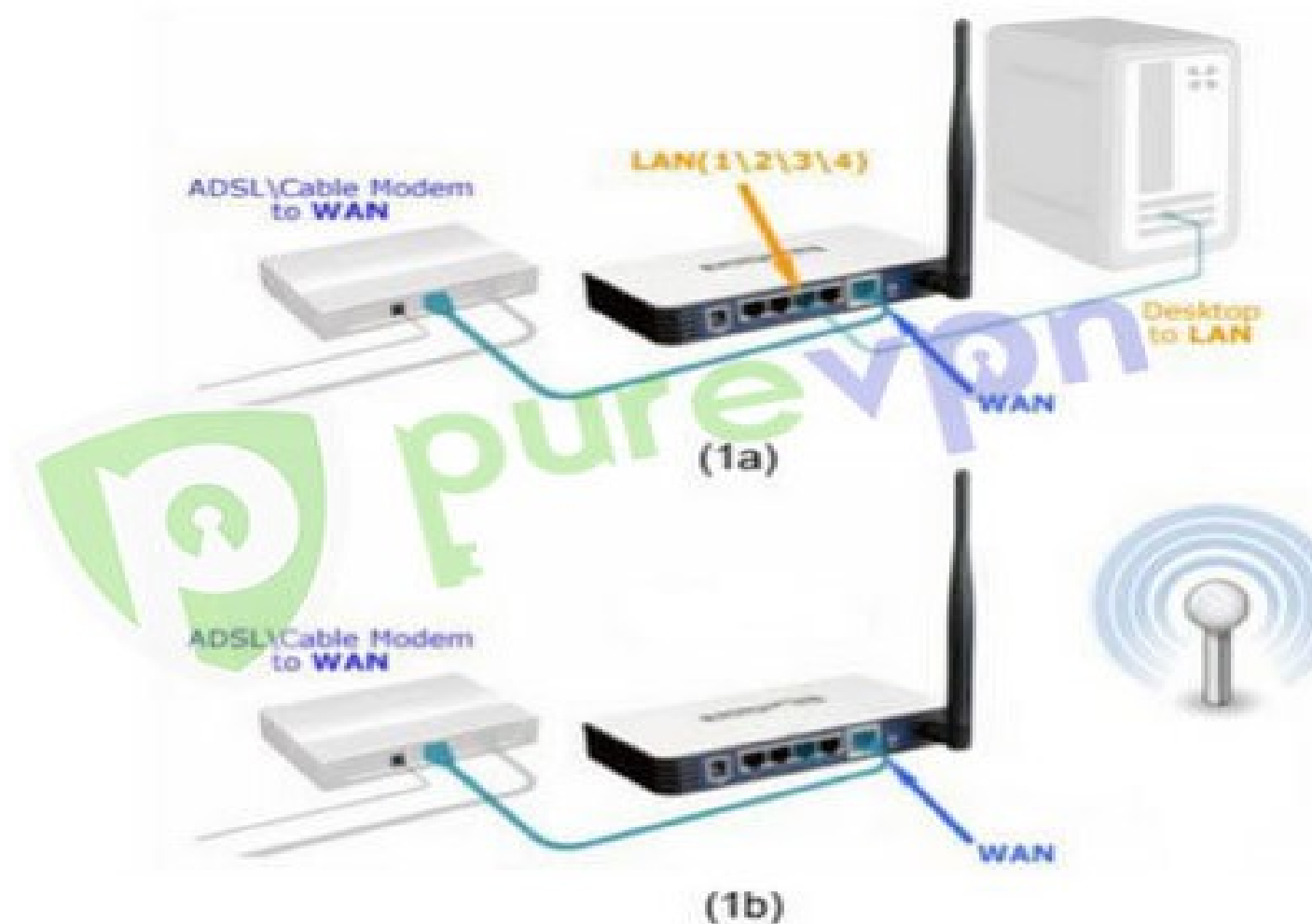

- Go to setup:

1. Click **Internet** tab on left hand navigation
2. Click **Manual** Internet Connection Setup
