

## How to Setup PureVPN on Linux via Command Line Interface

**Setting up PureVPN on your Linux is easy. What you only need to do is to check out the following guide on configuring PureVPN on Linux using the command line.**

1 In order to download the script, please refer to the command below that needs to be entered in the Linux Terminal

```
wget https://www.dropbox.com/s/nqv4xd32wmy2pcy/purevpn-pptp
```

Or if you wish to download directly please click [here](#).

2 Access the file location using cd/download

```
3 sudo chmod +x purevpn-pptp
```

```
4 sudo cp purevpn-pptp /usr/bin/
```

```
5 purevpn-pptp -li
```

From this point forward, you'll be directed to add your PureVPN username and password.

You will need to specify the server address/ hostname : `purevpn-pptp -c usca1.pointtoserver.com`

```
6 to check status purevpn -s
```

```
7 to check IP curl ipinfo.io
```

```
8 to disconnect purevpn -d
```

```
9 to logout purevpn -lo
```

## **Auto connect VPN on system start-up**

Type: crontab -e

Add the below command and save the file.

```
@reboot /bin/sh /home/jhon/Downloads/purevpn-pptp -c usca1.pointtoserver.com
```
