

How to setup PureVPN on Netgear Genie (Having Genie Firmware only)

Now you can have your Netgear Genie working with PureVPN too. You can refer to the step-by-step guide below to manually setup PureVPN within minutes.

Things to Consider:

Before you begin, please make sure that:

- You have a working internet connection
- VPN Supported Router.
- Own a premium PureVPN account (If you do not already own one, you can buy a subscription from [here](#))

1 Access your router control panel and click “VPN Client” from left side panel.

2 Place a “check” on “Enable VPN Client”.

3 Under “VPN Server” select PureVPN.

4 Under “VPN Protocol” select any desired protocol.

5 Under “Country” select any desired location of your choice.

6 Enter your VPN username and password accordingly and then click “Connect”.
