

How to Setup PureVPN on Slackware 14.2

Stay secure and anonymous on your Slackware 14.2 system using PureVPN. Here's how you can set up the VPN on Slackware easily.

Before setting up the VPN connection, you will have to follow these steps to enable the Network Manager.

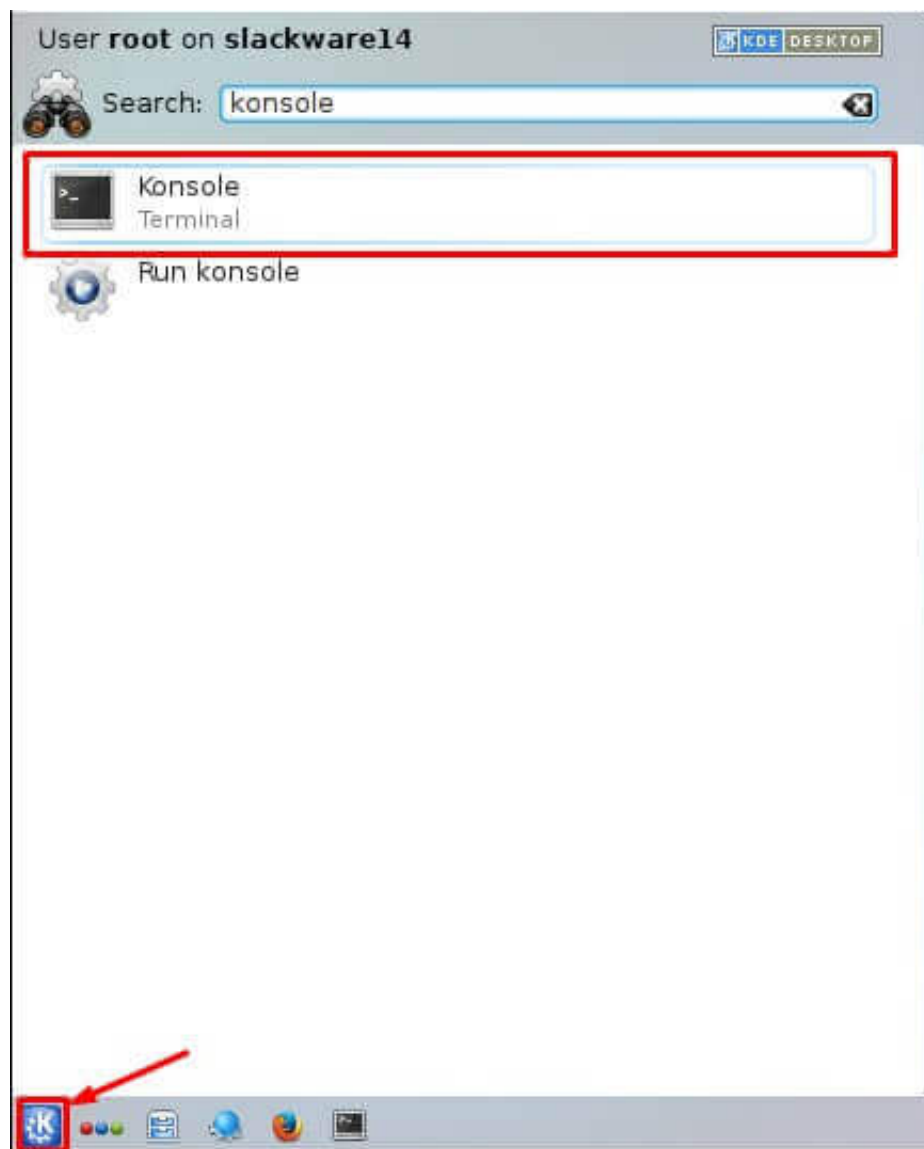
1 Download the PPTP packages from the link below:

2 Go to the **Launcher** and open **Konsole** (Terminal) then run the following commands one by one:



- `upgradepkg --install-new pptpd-1.4.0-x86_64-1_slack.tgz`
- `upgradepkg --install-new pptp-1.8.0-x86_64-1_slonly.tgz`
- `upgradepkg --install-new NetworkManager-pptp-1.2.4-x86_64-1_slonly.tgz`
- `sudo chmod +x /etc/rc.d/rc.networkmanager`
- `/etc/rc.d/rc.networkmanager start`

Once the setup is completed, follow the steps listed below to configure an **PPTP-VPN** connection in Slackware:

- 1 Click "**Wired Connections**" Icon and select the "**Settings**" option.

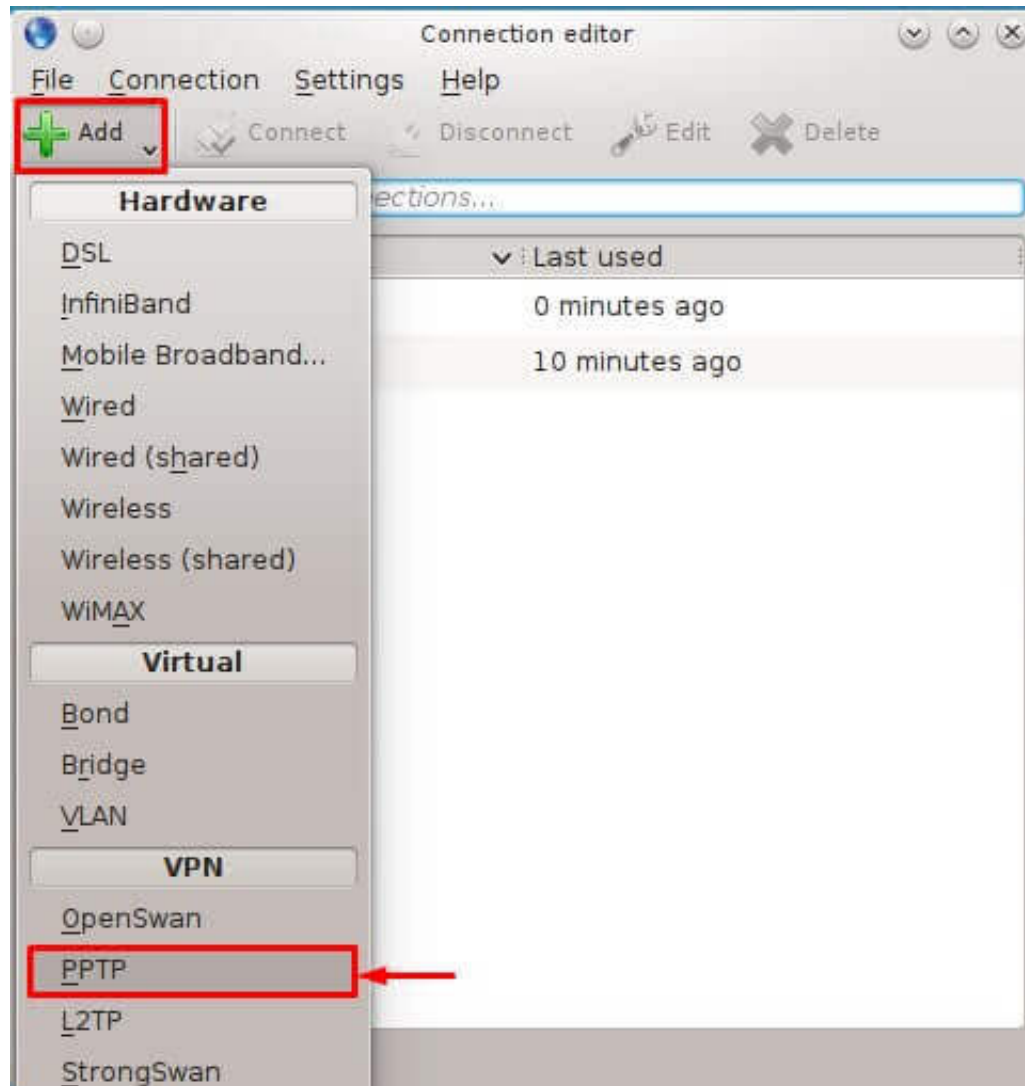

2 Click '**Add**' option to add a VPN connection and select '**PPTP**' from the drop-down list.



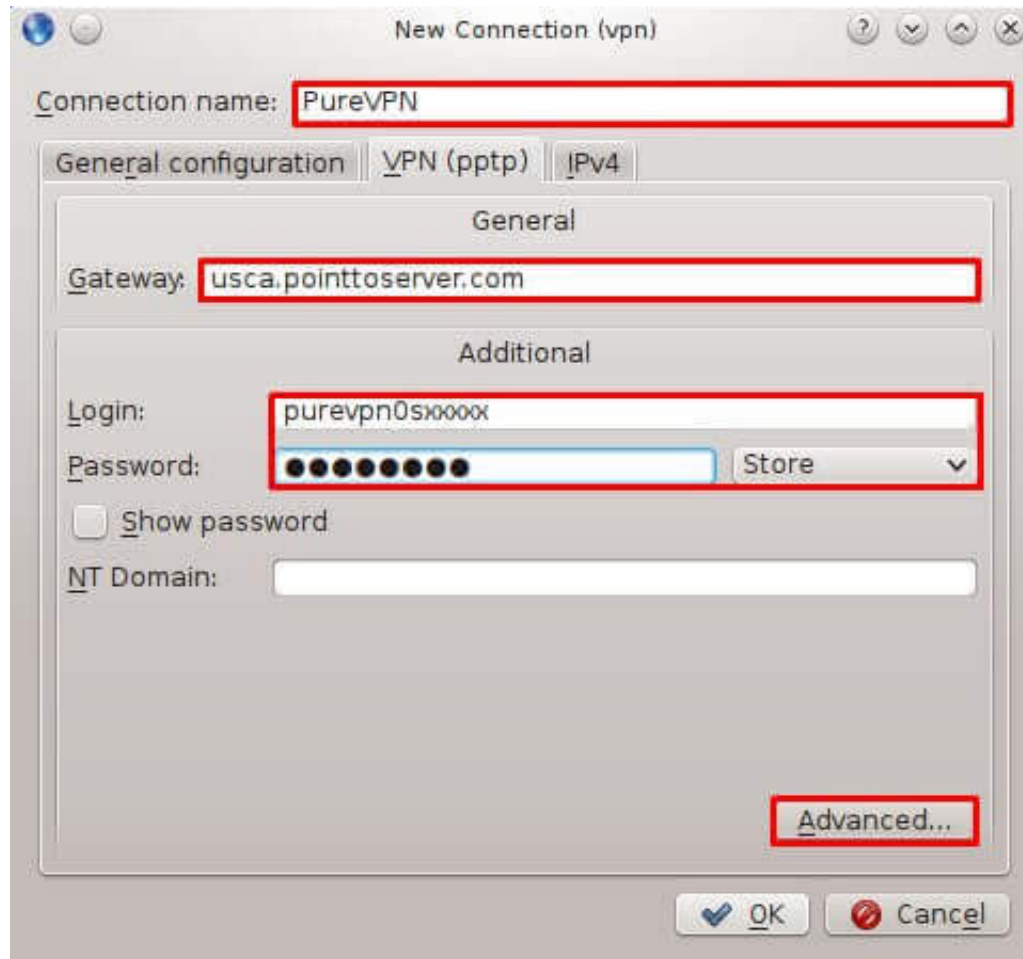
3 Enter the following info:

- Enter Connection name: **PureVPN**
- Enter Gateway: **pointtoserver.com** (you can use your desired server address here, in order to see the complete list [click here](#))
- Enter **Username** provided by **PureVPN**
- Enter **Password** provided by **PureVPN**

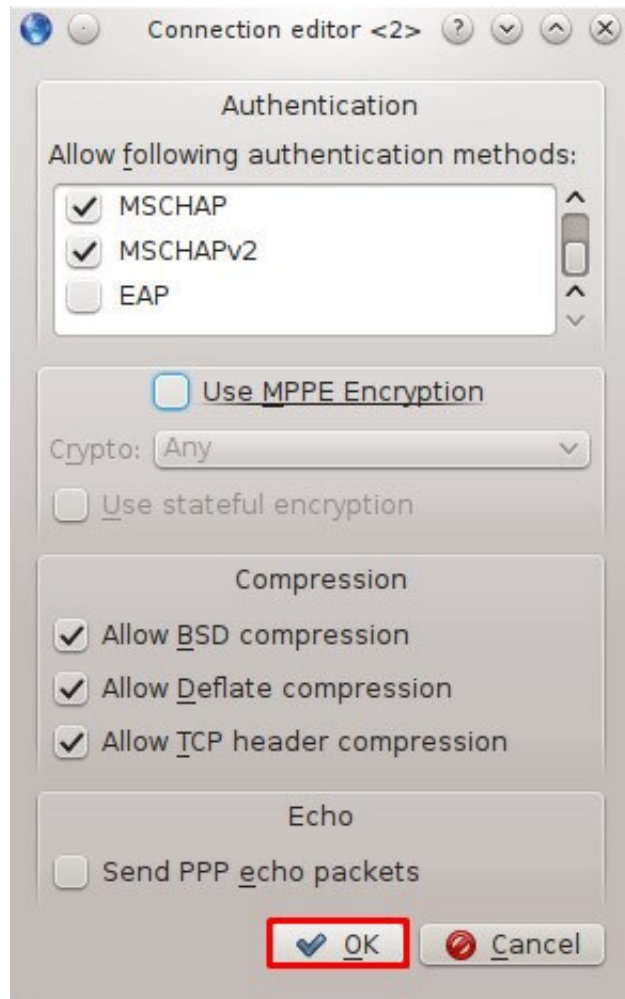

4 Click “**Advanced...**” option and check the following options under it:

- MSCHAP
- MSCHAP2
- Allow BSD compression
- Allow Deflate compression
- Allow TCP Header compression
- Click **OK**



5 Click **OK** and close **Networks** window.

6 Now Click **Wired Connections** Icon and select the newly created VPN connection, click on **Connect** button to connect to PureVPN.



7 You are connected to **PureVPN** now!
