Moreover, cookies can affect the operation of your VPN software, especially when you're browsing e-stores or using streaming services, by saving information about your location.

That's why sometimes websites can still think you're located in your home country even with an active VPN. Therefore, regular clearing your cookies and cache is not just useful but must-have.
