[OpenVPN](#) helps in creating and connecting a VPN network. The open-source protocol creates a secure server-client connection. It uses SSL/TLS for exchanges. Here's how you can setup OpenVPN manually:

Things to Consider:

Before you begin, please make sure that:

- You have a working internet connection
- Windows Supported Device.
- A Premium PureVPN account (If you haven't bought yet click [here](#) to buy)

Note: Dedicated IP addon can be only be connected with Ras protocol i.e PPTP/L2TP/SSTP.
