

How to Setup Openvpn on Mac Using Viscosity?

Things to Consider:

Before you begin, please make sure that:

- You have a working internet connection
- Mac Supported Device.
- A Premium PureVPN account (If you haven't bought yet click [here](#) to buy)

1 In order to configure OpenVPN on Mac, you need to download Viscosity and required OpenVPN files. Once 'Viscosity' is downloaded, drag it to 'Application' Icon

2 Go to applications and run “Viscosity”

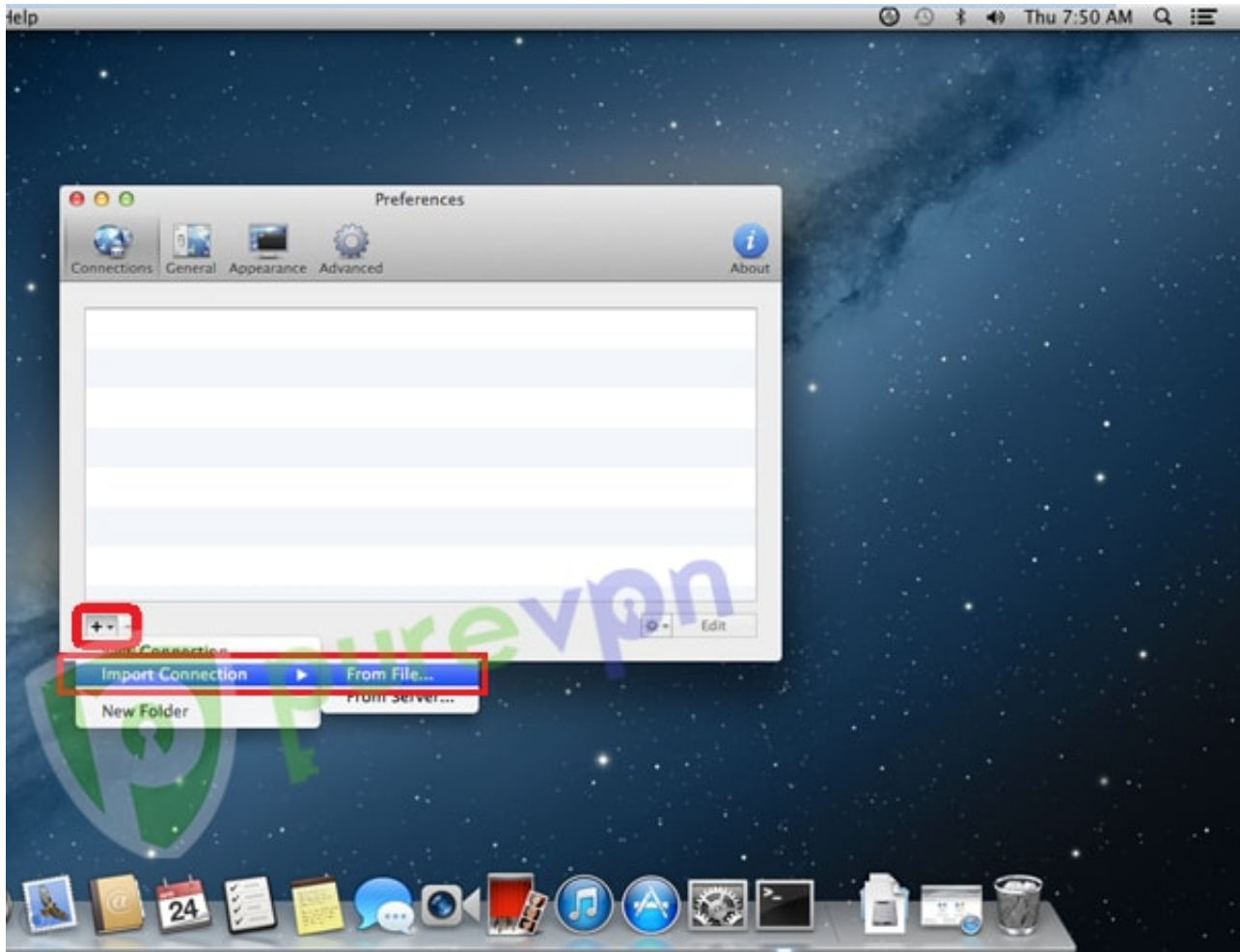


3 Click on Viscosity icon from Menu bar and select “Preferences..”

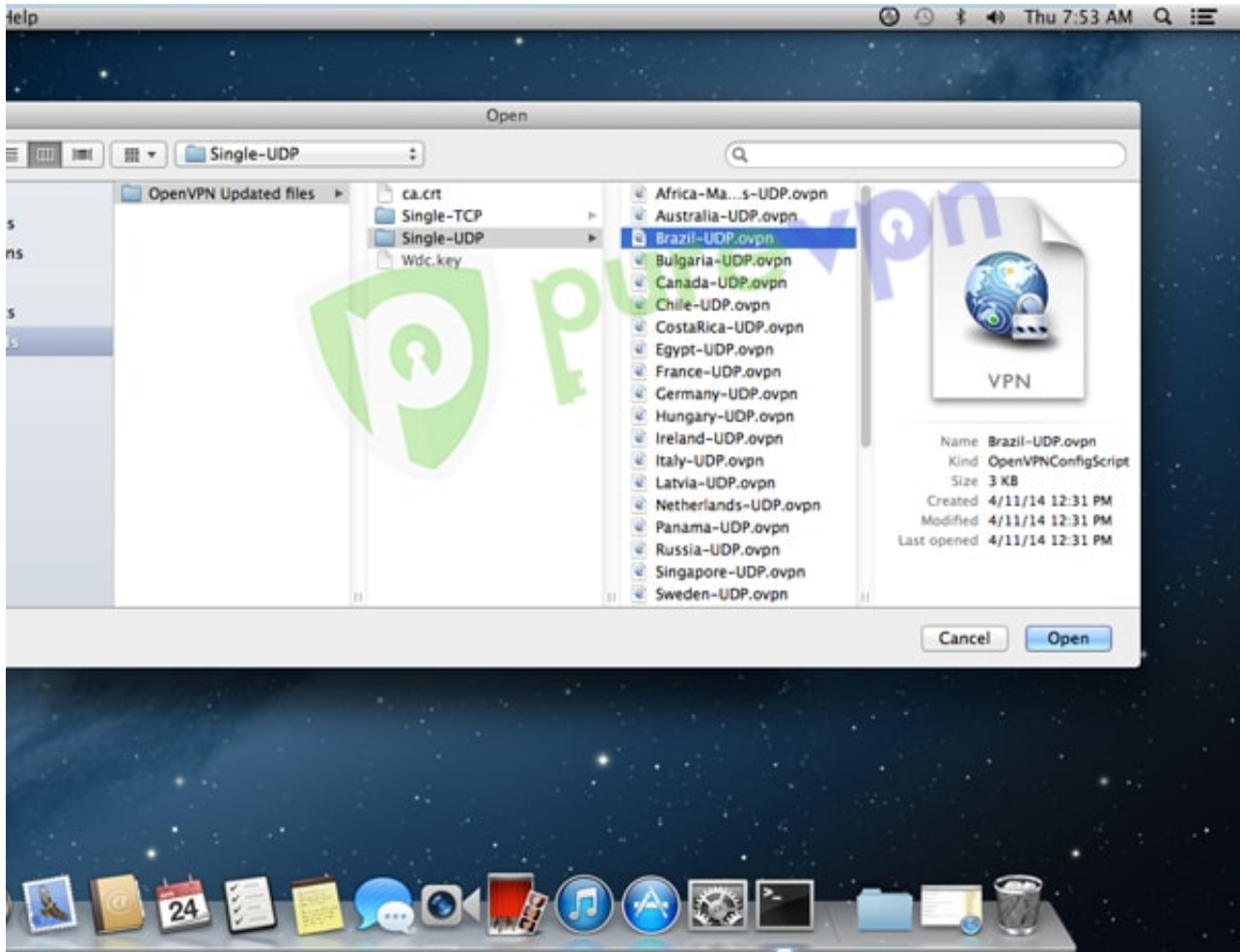


4 Do the following:

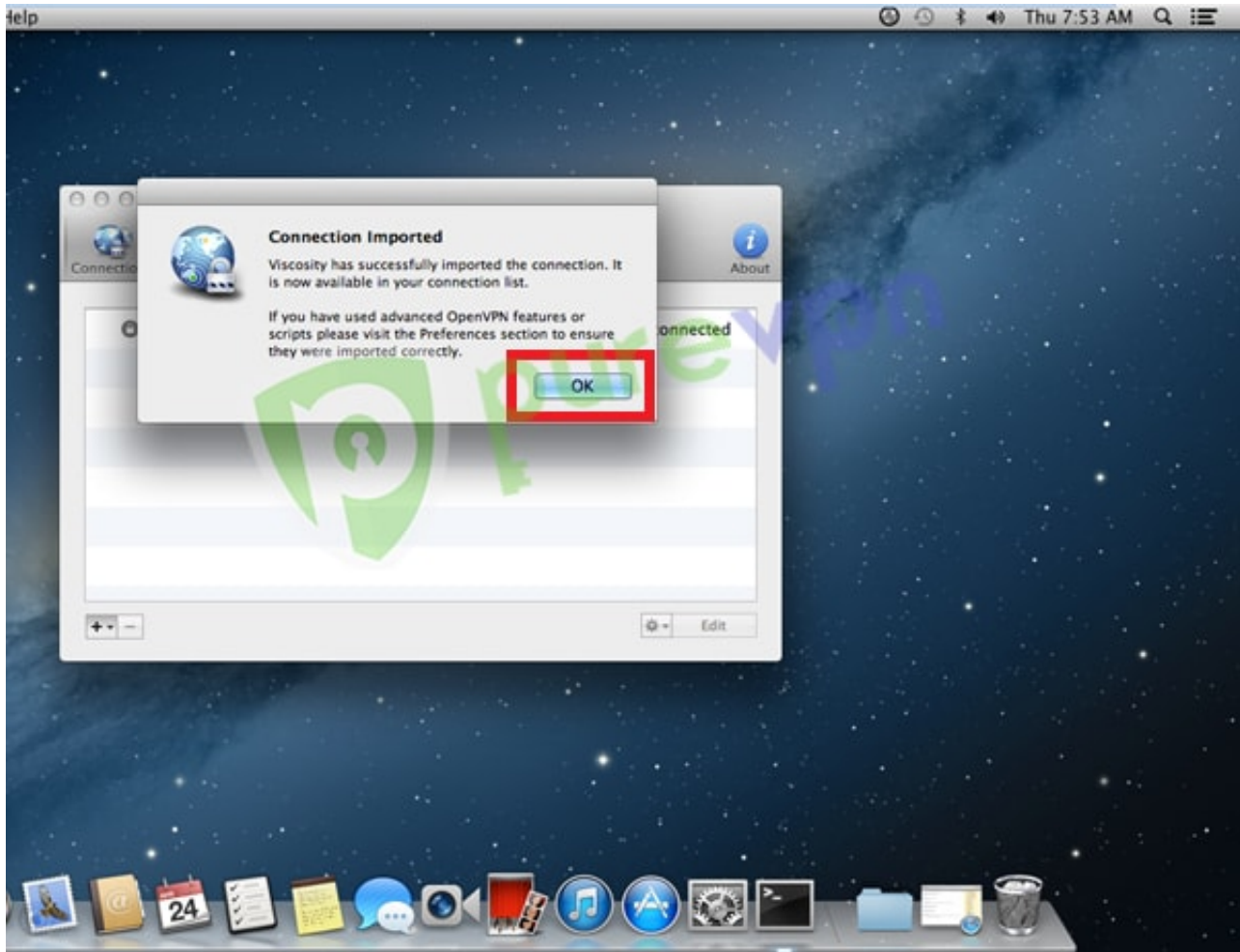
- Click on “+” icon
- Select Import Connection > From File



5 Select desired server from PureVPN OpenVPN files

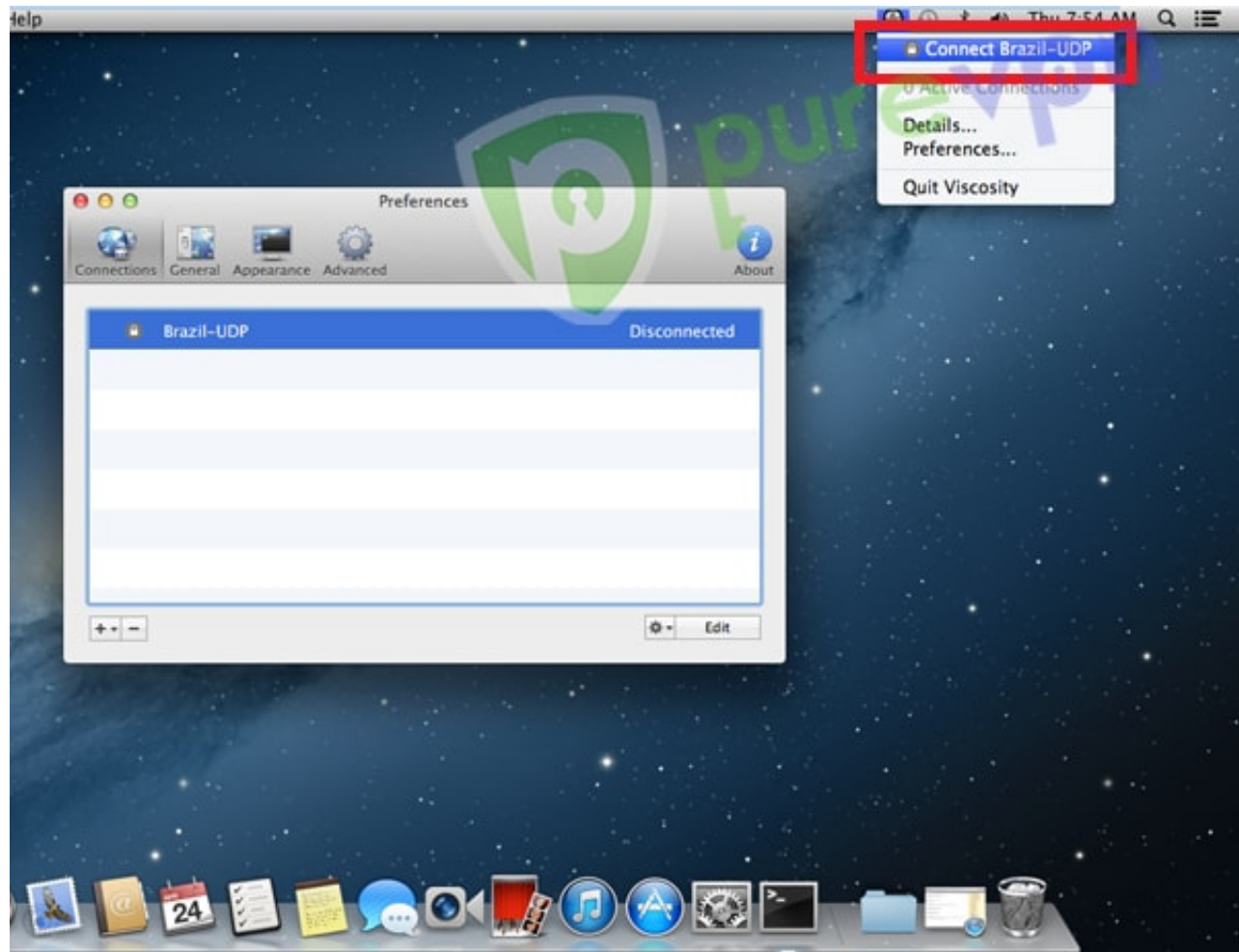


6 Click on "OK"



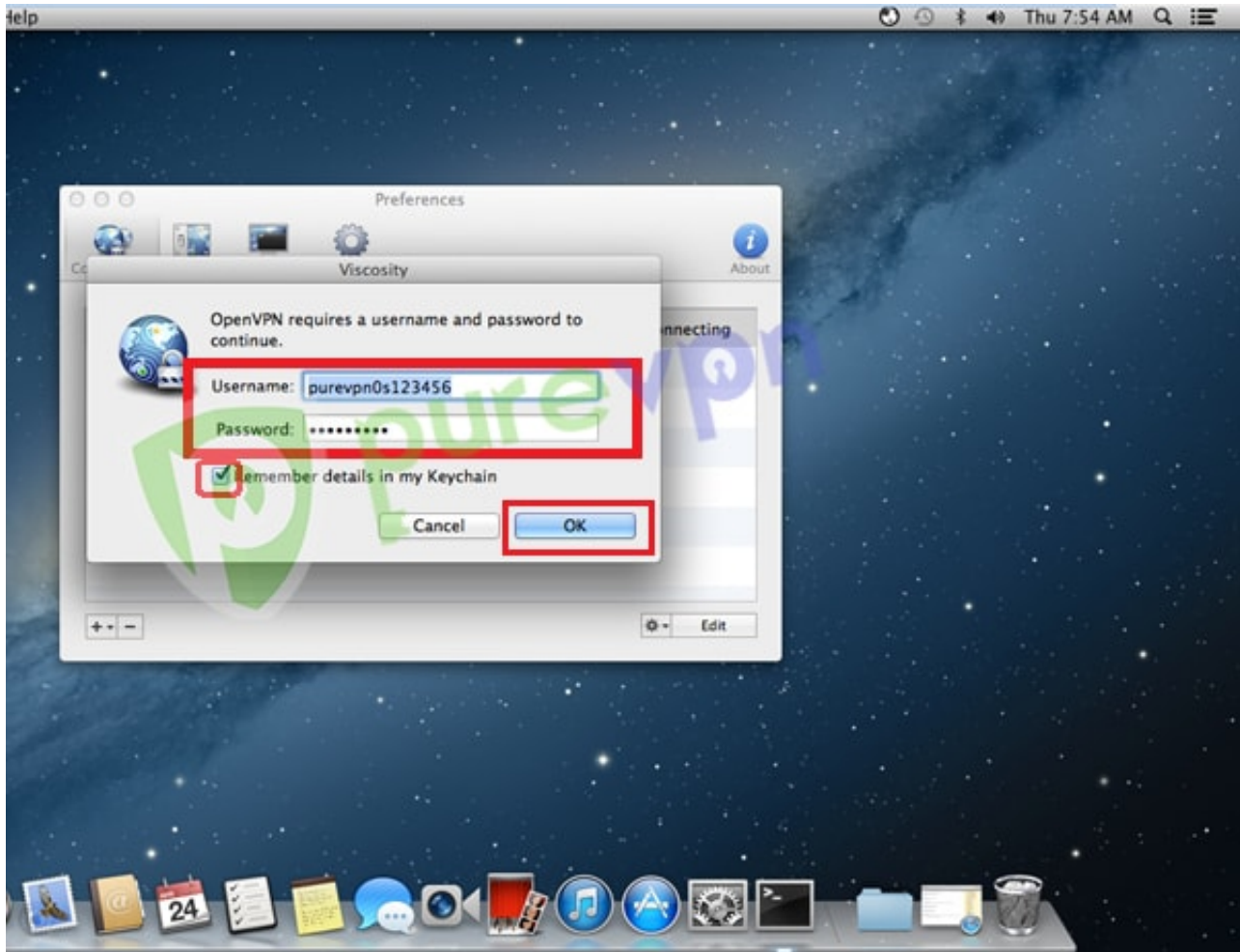
(Repeat the Step 4 – 6 to add more servers)

7 Click on Viscosity icon from Menu bar and select desired server

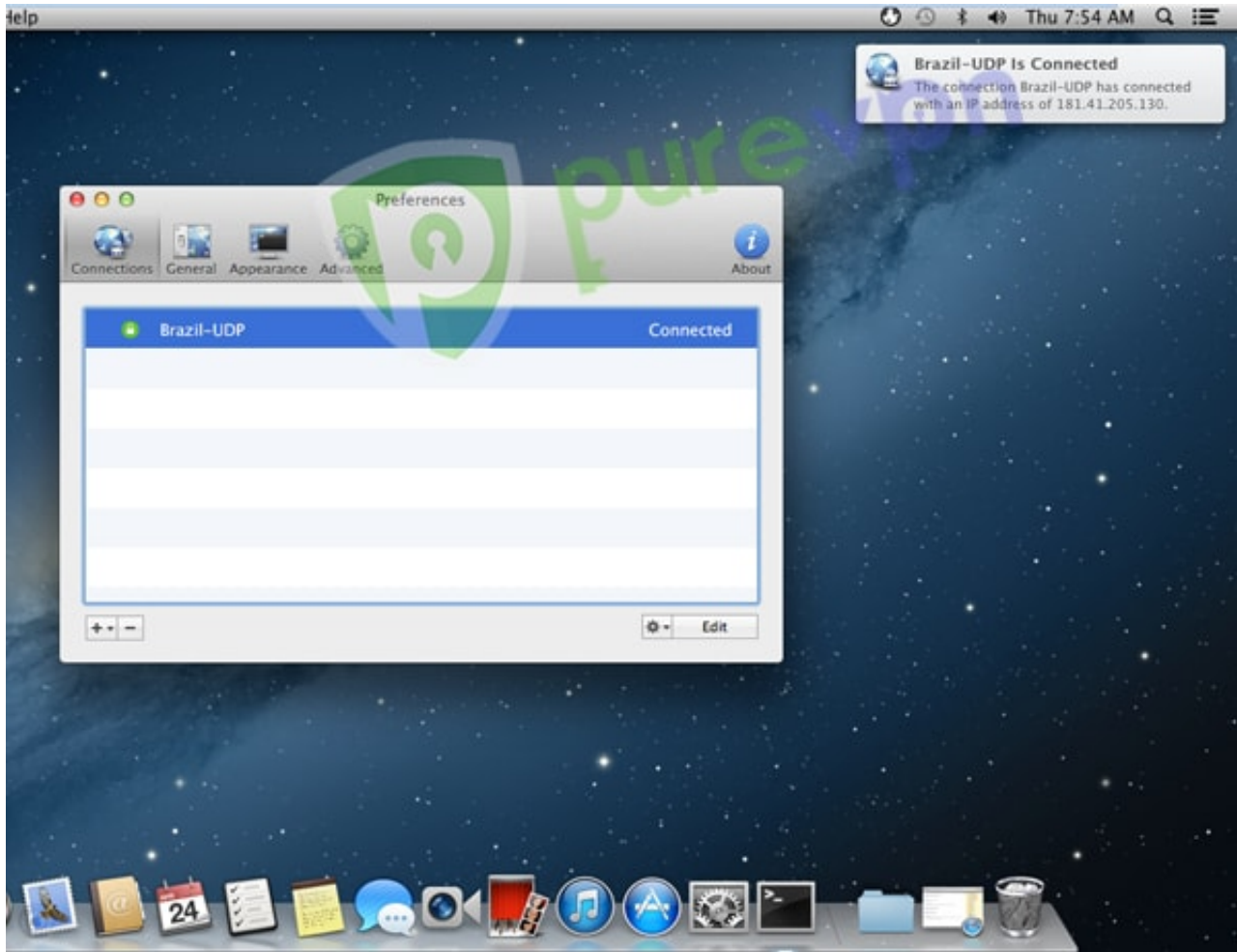


8 Insert the following info:

- Insert Username provided by PureVPN
- Insert Password provided by PureVPN
- Check “Remember details in my Keychain” to save account details.
- Click “OK”

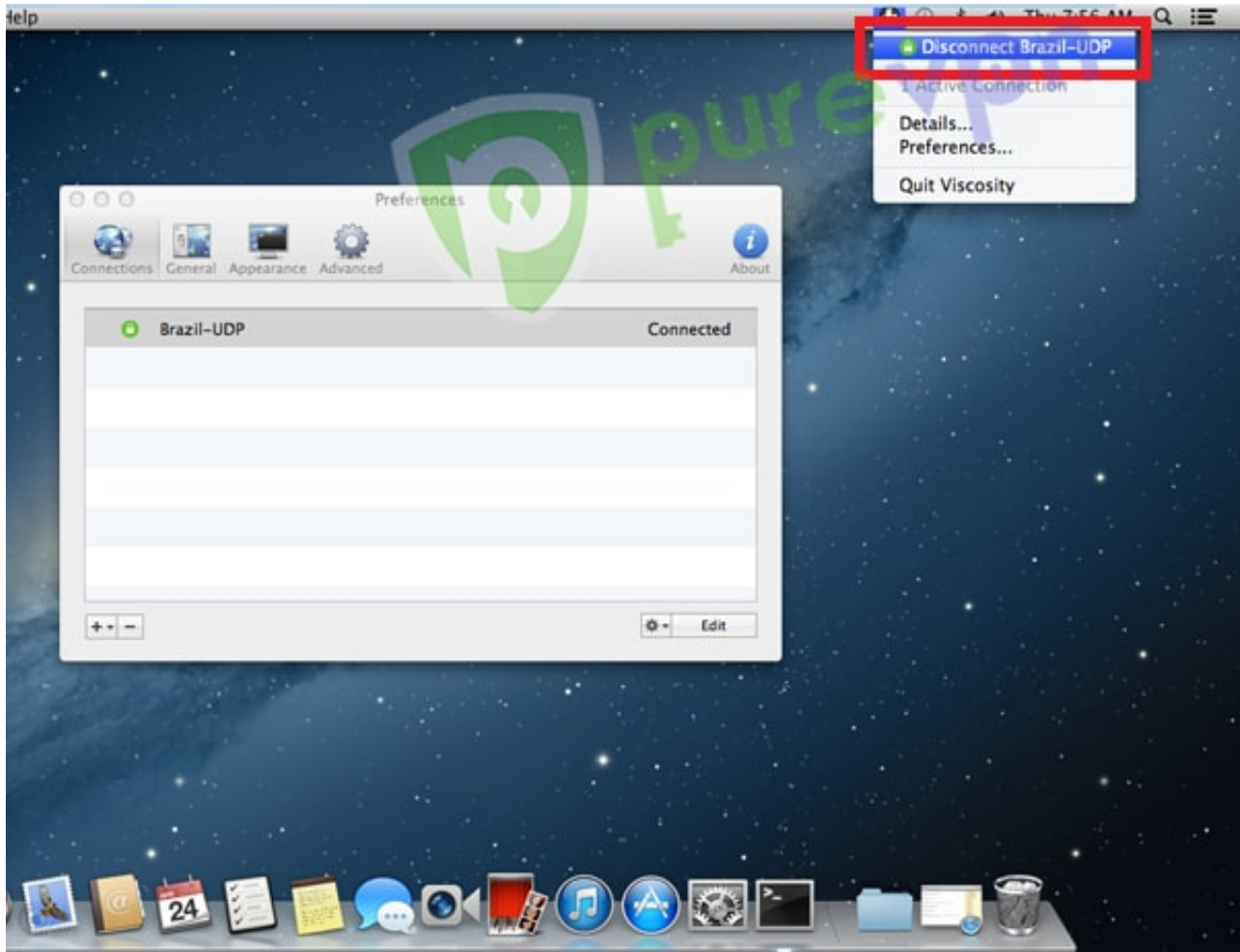


9 You are connected now. Enjoy Internet FREEDOM!
